Tour of Homes--Carolyn Prior reported that EAHS participated in the Shop Small Business Saturday on Main Street of Eaton. Some of the CH Store items were sold. The upcoming Eaton's Old Fashioned Christmas on Saturday, December 10, will feature a tour of the decorated A. J. Eaton Home and Carriage House Museum. Also, local photographer Nina Lewis will offer Mini Photo sessions as a fundraiser for the museum. An ad for this event was run in the 11/24/22 issue of the Herald, but we need to run a followup ad before December 10.

Public Relations--Our participation in Colorado Gives Day on December 6

will not happen this year due to registration difficulties.

Carriage House--The final inspection of the CH by the town is closer to being completed. Also, the town has paid for everything so far. A custom built shed that will match the CH is now in the works. Ken Bell will head this project.

New Business--Discussion was had about the following: a Mimmack Memorial at the museum, possibly donating to the Eaton Library's sculpture project, and what to do with the EAHS items stored in Russ Leffler's building.

The Annual Meeting will be held Saturday, January 14, 2023. The letters to the membership will be mailed out soon.
