The Eaton Area Historical Society general meeting was held Monday, November 27, 2023, at 6:30 PM at the Eaton Area Community Center. 6 members were present. The treasurer's report was as follows:

Committee Reports:

- Museum Care--the museum care committee has accomplished the following; Boy's room: cleaned top to bottom, orange oiled all furniture, new sheet set on bed, new antique toys, games and trophies. Library; cleaned top to bottom, orange oiled bookcases, cleaned and organized bookshelves, new displays and new arrangement of items. Master bedroom; orange oiled furniture, antique crocheted bedspread and winter dress on display. Entryway; cleaned. Fireplace room; cleaned bookcases and chandelier, new display of items, new furniture arrangement. Parlor; new furniture arrangement. Christmas decorations throughout the house.
- Fund Raiser--Terri James reported that 36 members and 8 guests will be attending the December 2nd Open House party. \$1400 collected so far for the party. Christmas quilt raffle tickets netted \$650. Discussion followed about supplies, beverages, food, music, etc. On December 9, Eaton's Old Fashion Christmas, the museum will be open the usual hours of 10-2 and should have more than 2 volunteers. Volunteers needed to provide cookies for the event.
